
We welcome you to our church family. As a child of God, you have been granted the same rights, advantages, privileges, and protection He provides for all that belong to Him.


CHURCH HISTORY

Outreach Church of The Rock was formally established on June 13, 2016, by Pastor Jessie Green, III and First Lady Cheryl Green, alongside three charter members. The inaugural worship service took place on July 10, 2016, at the Best Western Plus meeting room, located at 922 East Highway 67, Duncanville, Texas. The congregation continued to gather at this location until March 2020, when services transitioned to an online format in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The property located at 410 East Avenue F, Midlothian, Texas, was graciously gifted by Frankie Mathis in honor of her mother, Sister Rosie Sanders. On October 4, 2020, following the official signing and filing of the deed with the county, the building was established as the new home of Outreach Church of The Rock.

Construction of the new church home commenced on November 9, 2020, marking a significant milestone in our journey. On May 14, 2021, the Midlothian Chamber of Commerce proudly hosted the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony. The legacy of Sister Rosie Sanders lives on, inspiring generations to come.

OUR MISSION


To be a church that displays the love of God, faith in Christ, and to connect all people through the Holy Spirit.

WE BELIEVE



BASIC CHURCH ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES

Arrive on Time

Arriving before the service starts shows respect for God, the worship experience, and others. Late arrivals can be distracting to those already engaged in worship.

Silence Your Phone – Turn off or silence all electronic devices before entering the sanctuary to avoid interruptions during prayer, preaching, and worship.

Avoid Walking Around During the Service

Unless necessary (such as an emergency or restroom break), remain seated once the service begins to minimize distractions and maintain a spirit of reverence.

No Eating or Drinking in the Sanctuary

Food and beverages should be consumed outside of the sanctuary to preserve the cleanliness and sacredness of the worship space.

No Playing in the Pulpit or on the Altar

The pulpit and altar are consecrated spaces reserved for clergy and worship leaders. Children and visitors should be reminded not to play, run, or sit in these areas.

Be Reverent During the Service

Show respect by paying attention, participating appropriately, and refraining from side conversations or disruptive behavior during the service.

GETTINGS INVOLVED

Getting involved means actively contributing to the life and work of the church, which can foster a deeper sense of community and spiritual growth by participating in various activities, ministries, and roles that support the church's mission and community. This involvement can take many forms, including:

Volunteering

Offering time and skills to help with church operations, such as serving in the choir, helping with children's ministry, assisting with hospitality, or participating in outreach programs.

Joining a Ministry

Leadership Roles


Taking on leadership positions, such as serving on the church board, leading a small group, or coordinating events and programs.
